(When God comes through in the clutch)
Part 3 of 8

Genesis 22:1-14 (NLT)

“Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles. And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, fixing our eyes on Jesus” **Hebrews 12:1-2**

Starting Point:

“God I don’t understand what you are doing RIGHT NOW”

Destination Point:

“But God always come through in the clutch”

“If, in fact, Abraham was justified by works, he had something to boast about—but not before God. What does Scripture say? “Abraham believed God, and it was credited to him as righteousness.” Now to the one who works, wages are not credited as a gift but as an obligation. However, to the one who does not work but trusts God who justifies the ungodly, their faith is credited as righteousness.” **Romans 4:2-5**

“In the same way, faith by itself, if it is not accompanied by action, is dead.” **James 2:17**

“By faith Abraham, when God tested him, offered Isaac as a sacrifice. He who had embraced the promises was about to sacrifice his one and only son, even though God had said to him, “It is through Isaac that your offspring will be reckoned.” Abraham reasoned that God could even raise the dead” **Hebrews 11:17-19**

“The Spirit of God, who raised Jesus from the dead, lives in you” **Romans 8:11**

“He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all—how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things?” **Romans 8:32**

Apps:
